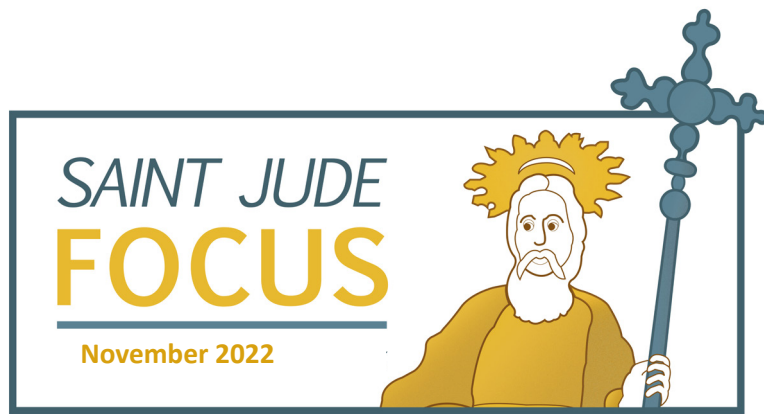




News from the Shrine of Saint Jude
